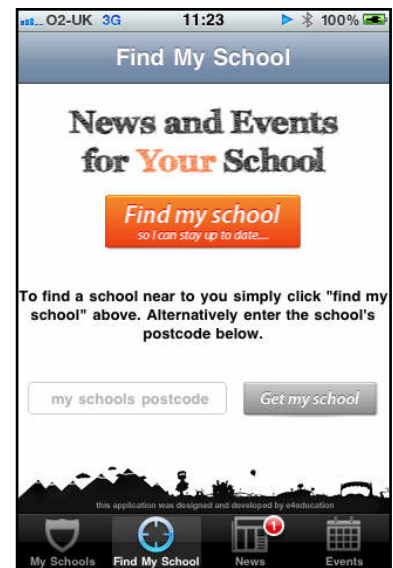

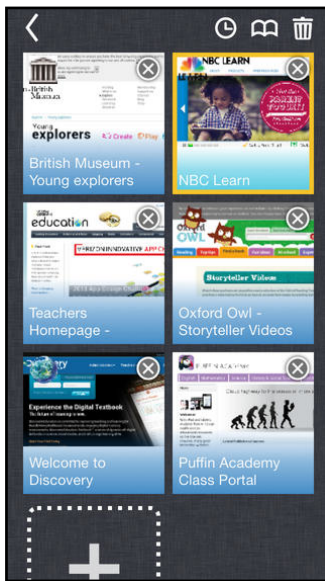

Use 2DIY on your iPad

Children in Years 3 to 6 use a program called 2DIY to make their own computer games. You can download a free copy of this software onto your iPad by following the instructions below:

- On the iPad, open Safari and visit www.thedowns.me
- Click on Purple Mash and log in (using the details on your child's MCard).
- Click on the 2DIY icon and choose one of the apps.
- Follow the instructions to download the app from the App Store.
- The app usually costs £7.99 but you can use it for free with your Purple Mash details.
