

Term Four News from Year 6 – Make it Work

Welcome back we hope you all had a lovely half term. This is going to be another busy term! During term 4 our learning is going to be based around the topic theme 'Make it Work'. We are approaching this topic through studying

Literacy - We will continue to look at different genres of writing, including; arguments, Biographical reports and narrative writing. We will continue reading Street Child and also develop the children's inference and deduction skills from a variety of different text types. In addition to this, Year 6 will also be reviewing their spelling, grammar and punctuation skills.

Maths - This term we will be focussing on how children apply their mathematical knowledge to solving multi-step problems which in turn will help their deeper understanding of this subject. We will continue to practice basic arithmetic skills.

Topic - In Science, we will be learning about Light. Our RE lessons will focus on Christianity, the children will be learning about the topic of Salvation. What difference does the resurrection make to Christians?

PE - PE is on Monday and Friday. The children will be developing different multi-skills and learning how to improve on their personal achievements. Also the children will be learning the game of tennis. Children will need to have the correct outdoor kit in school at all times.
