During term 2 the topic theme is 'Eureka!'

Literacy

The children will continue to develop their understanding of the different aspects of SPaG (Spelling, punctuation and grammar), as well as developing their inference and deduction skills in guided reading sessions. There will be a range of writing outcomes as we begin to develop the children's writing portfolios.

Maths

The children will continue to become more accurate in all four operations, ensuring that they use the most efficient methods to solve one-step and two-step word problems. There will also be a focus on developing the understanding of real-life problems in the outdoor setting.

Topic

In Science, we will be learning about electricity, the pupils will be undertaking varied tasks and experiments. In Geography, we will focus on mapping skills linked to the local area.

PE

The children will be developing a variety of different P.E. skills. Children will need to have the correct outdoor and indoor P.E kit with a carrier bag to put dirty trainers into.

RE

This term the children will be looking at the gospel and thinking of the big question – What would Jesus do?
