

Term Three News from Year 6 – Horrible Histories

Welcome back. We hope you all had a safe and peaceful Christmas.

During term 3 our learning is going to be based around the topic theme 'Horrible Histories'. We are approaching this topic through studying the novel '*Street Child*' by Berlie Doherty. We will focus on Victorian life.

Literacy - The children will be analysing the text with a strong focus on what is inferred by the author as well as literal responses. They will be writing a descriptive text, a play script and a short story. They will also be continuing to learn spelling rules and there will be a high expectation on presentation and handwriting skills within recorded work.

Maths - They will continue to develop their understanding of the four operations and increasingly apply them to more complex word problems. There will also be a focus on using efficient written strategies to solve a range of questions under timed conditions.

Topic - In Science, we will be learning and reviewing our knowledge about Light. Our RE lessons will focus on the religion Islam and the children will be learning about the different features associated with Islam.

PE - PE is on Monday and Friday. The children will be developing their skills through the games of Rugby and Hockey. Children will need to have the correct outdoor kit in school at all times. This includes the removal of earrings prior to the PE lesson.
