


<p>Maths WALT count to 50 Sequencing numbers to 50 (thenational.academy) Today we are going to be counting forwards and backwards to 50 starting from any number. A good game to play is to ask your adult to say any starting number and then to count up to 50 from that number. PM 2D0 upload your work Unit 9 - 1</p>	<p>Maths WALT counting to 50 We are going to continue with our counting today. First ask your adult to give you a starting number and then count up to 50. If you have snakes and ladders at home enjoy a game with your adults. PM 2D0 upload your work Unit 9 - 2</p>	<p>Maths WALT partition into tens and ones Exploring tens and ones (thenational.academy) You will need some pasta / lego to help you today. We are going to be grouping in to tens to make our counting easier. Today with your adult can you make 3 tens frames onto a piece of card ready for tomorrow's lesson. PM2D0</p>	<p>Maths WALT partition numbers You will need your tens frames and counters / pasta / lego. Ask your adult to say a number up to 30 e.g. 23. Count out this number of counters. Now fill in your tens frames. How many tens have you made ... 2 and how many 'odd' ones have you got ...3. So you have 2 tens and 3 ones.
