



Week beginning 13th September 2021

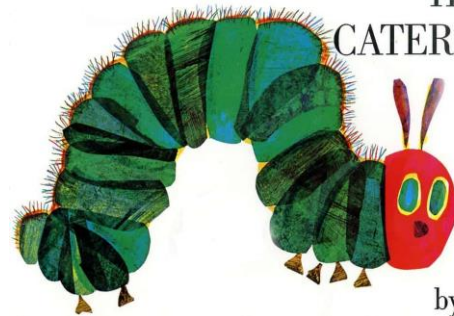
We had a wonderful start to our learning journey together last week and have been getting to know each other, making friends and getting used to finding our way around the classroom.

Let me tell you what happens in this story...

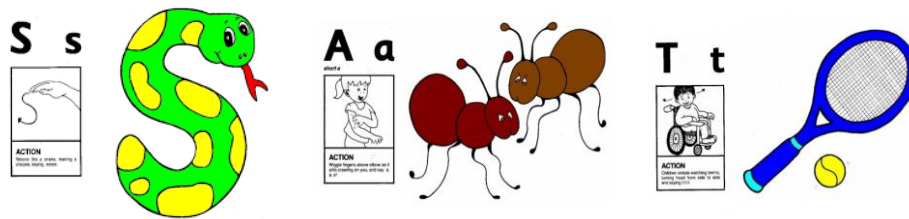
We have been exploring our role play areas!

The fruit and vegetable shop is open. We have lots of healthy food on sale. Let me tell you what I like doing in here.

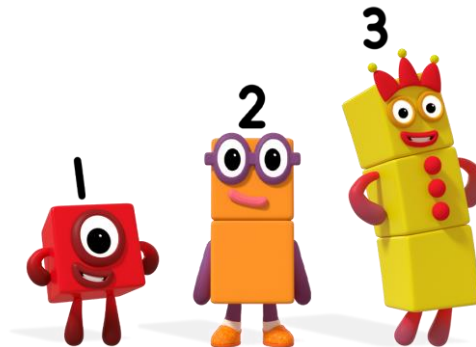
This week we will begin phonics and will be introduced to the sounds:
